Day 01. Monday, October 6, 2025

Meals: Dinner

Arrival to Thessaloniki. Welcome Dinner.

Orientation

Overnight in Thessaloniki.

Day 02. Tuesday, October 7, 2025

Meals: Breakfast

Today we will explore the second largest city of Greece. We will start our day with a visit to the **Basilica of St. Great Martyr Demetrius of Thessalonica**, heavenly patron of the city. From there on we will continue the exploration of the city that will include visits to the historical parts of the city with the remains of the imposing Roman Ruins,





Byzantine fortifications and the **Archeological Museum** one of the finest in all of Greece.
Overnight in **Thessaloniki**.

Day 03. Wednesday, October 8, 2025

Meals: Breakfast

Today we will continue the exploration of the city of Thessaloniki. We will visit the Cathedral and will venerate the relics of St. Gregory Palamas, the great teacher and defender of Orthodoxy, mighty church of St. Sophia and Osios David Monastery with the splendid Roman mosaic depicting Christ as eternal youth. In the afternoon

we will visit the Byzantine Museum with its extraordinary collection of the Byzantine Antiquities. Overnight in **Thessaloniki**.

Day 04. Thursday, October 9, 2025

Meals: Breakfast and Dinner

After breakfast we will transfer to **Berea**, a little town famous for being mentioned in the Acts of the Apostles as one of the places where the Apostle Paul visited during his missionary journeys. The quiet town has some splendid ecclesiastical monuments to offer for your enjoyment. From here we will travel a bit SW to explore the **archeological park of Vergina**, with the decorated **tombs** of Macedonian royalty, father of Alexander of Macedon who created one of the mightiest Empires our world had ever




known. For dinner and overnight we will transfer to Kalampaka, at the foot of the Meteora cliffs.

Day 05. Friday, October 10, 2025

Meals: Breakfast and Dinner

This morning we will explore one of the most beautiful and holy places of Greece, the **Meteora**. Monasteries and convents sit on top of huge rock formations almost as bird nests. There are a number of



them in the area and we will some most important of them. In the afternoon we will transfer some hours south to the vicinity of the renowned Ancient Greeks site of **Delphi**.

Day 06. Saturday, October 11, 2025

Meals: Breakfast and Dinner

Today we will explore two magnificent sites that serve as remarkable complexes to two distinctively different period of history of Greece. One is the complex of the **Delphi Oracle Temple**, most famous place in all of

Ancient Greece. Museum on the ground hold a remarkable collection of antiquities found by the archeologists on site. Another complex is that of the Monastery of Saint Luke (Hosios Lukas) named after 11 century ascetic founder of the Monastery. The main church is splendidly decorated by mosaics, some of the best in all of Greece. Due to it special architecture and the art work, monastery was added to the UNESCO World Heritage list. Dinner and overnight in Nafpaktos/Patras/area.



Day 07. Sunday, October 12, 2025

Meals: Breakfast

Our day we will start with a visit to the

largest Cathedral in all of Greece, dedicated to St. Andrew the First Called, the Apostle of our Lord. The



mighty marble cathedral houses part of the relics of the Apostle (his skull) and part of the "X" shaped cross upon which he was crucified. In the afternoon we will transfer East and will explore the ruins of **Mycenae**, the capital city of arguably the oldest civilization of Ancient Greece. For dinner and overnight we will arrive to **Nafplion**.

Day 8. Monday, October 13, 2025

Meals: Breakfast

After a walking tour of **Nafplio**, we will visit the ruins of **Corinth**, where **Apostle Paul** preached, along with the remains of the city's harbor of Kapnikarea. In the afternoon, before our arrival

to Athens we will visit one of the most famous Byzantine monuments, the **Monastery of Dafni**. Splendid golden mosaics demonstrate the talent of the Medieval craftsman and the love for the beauty of God' Holy house. Overnight in Athens.

Day 9. Tuesday, October 14, 2025

Athens is on the 'must see' list of every traveler. Who does not know how hauntingly majestic the Parthenon looks? We will visit that "Wonder of the World", and then we will explore ancient sites nearby. In the afternoon we will plan to visit the National Museum of Greece, with doubtlessly best collection of Greek Antiquities in the World. Overnight in Athens.





During the last day of our trip we will continue exploration of **Athens** with visit to several Medieval Byzantine Churches in Plaka. Later in the morning we will visit wonderful **Byzantine Museum**, famous for its reach collections of the Byzantine Antiquities. Your afternoon will be at leisure. Our farewell dinner will be in one of the local taverns. Overnight in Athen reakfast at the hotel and departure from the Athens International Airport "Eleftherios Venizelos" [ATHs

The deposit is non-refundable, unless pilgrimage is cancelled by the organizers due to lack of participation or for some other valid or unforeseen circumstance. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

REGISTRATION DEADLINE: The deadline for signing up for the trip is July 5, 2025. The entire amount is due 91 days prior to departure, July 5, 2025. Failure to pay in full by July 5, 2025, without written notice of explanation may lead to the cancellation of your participation, with no refund of any previously committed funds.

CANCELLATION POLICY: If you need to cancel after you signed up, penalty is:

- 25% of the tour cost, 91 to 61 days prior to the departure
- 50% of the tour cost, 61 to 31 days prior to the departure
- 100% of the tour cost 31 or fewer days prior to the departure

All cancellations must be done in writing as well and sent directly to agent/coordinator - Fr. Ilya Gotlinsky and must be received for reimbursement by the dates shown in the cancellation schedule. We also have to add that should cancellation or alteration of the program occur due to COVID and associated emergencies, civil disturbances, acts of terrorism, war, natural disaster, and other events of force majeur or acts of God (including threat or fear of same), refunds will be made only to the extent that they are recoverable, and that such cancellation or alteration may result in the total loss of funds paid by participants.
